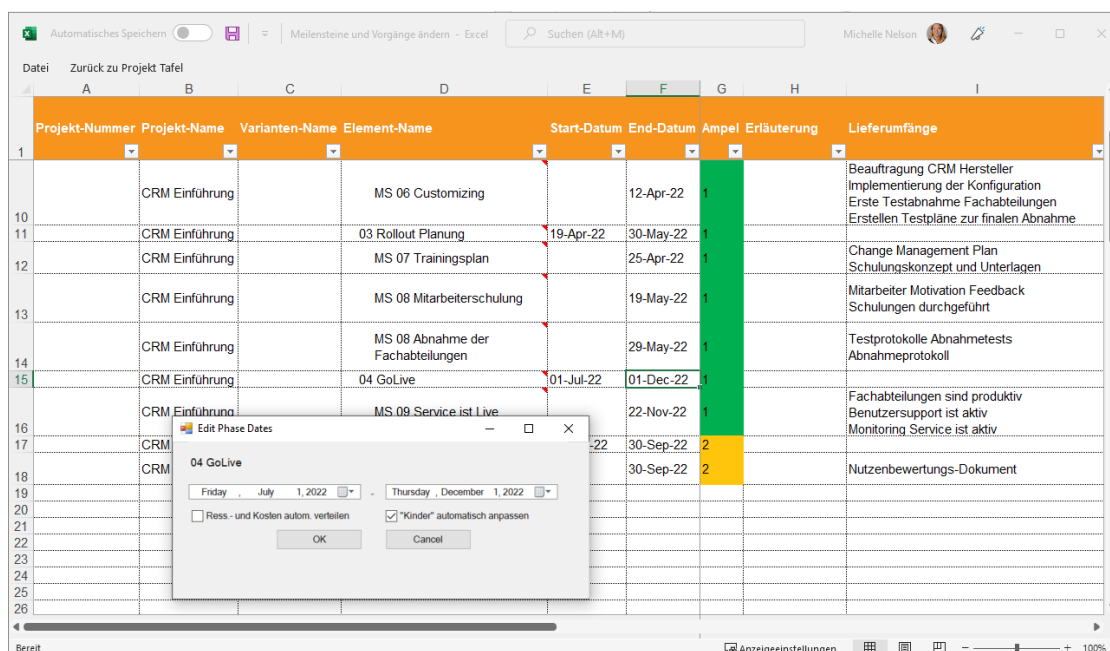
- Projekte werden automatisiert angelegt oder erweitert beim Benutzen eines Cost-Assertion-Sheets und einer Projekt-Vorlage (VS-1092)

Beim Benutzen eines Kostendeckungsblatt und einer Projektvorlage mit vorgegebener Projekt- und Phasenstruktur wird ein Projekt erstellt oder aktualisiert, in dem alle Elemente, die sich auf eine bestimmte Phase beziehen, aggregiert werden und der entsprechende Phasen-, Rollen-, oder PT-Betrag zum Erstellen oder Aktualisieren des Projekts verwendet wird.

- Änderung von Zeitplänen skaliert die Ressourcenplanung nicht automatisch (VS-1109)

Beim Verlängern von Terminen für zukünftige Phasen und Meilensteine eines existierenden Projektes wird die Ressourcenverteilung nicht automatisch gestreckt, sondern am Ende der Phasen mit Nullen aufgefüllt. Ressourcen werden auch bei einer Verkürzung der Projektphase nicht automatisch skaliert.

Um diese automatische Skalierung auszusetzen, darf die Einstellung „Ress. Und Kosten autom. Verteilen“ nicht aktiviert sein.
